House of the Day: Modernist Masterpiece in Manhattan

There are several reasons we dig these digs in [Manhattan](#). One, it's located in the Upper East Side's landmarked modernist icon, the [Manhattan House](#). Two, it's designed by the celebrated [James Huniford](#), one of Architectural Digest's "Top 100 Designers," as part of his Modern Collection series. Plus, it's filled with artwork from [VOLTZ Clarke's](#) finest contemporary artists.

And it can be all yours for a modest (for New York City) price of [\\$6.1 million](#). Which, frankly, for what you're getting, is not a bad deal if you have that kind of money at your disposal. Not only is it beautiful thanks to Huniford's aesthetic genius -- south-facing windowed walls overlooking Manhattan House's private gardens, soft grays and calming jade-green color themes throughout - - but it also boasts three spacious bedrooms with en-suite marble bathrooms, a media room, a chef's kitchen featuring Viking Professional appliances and a windowed eat-in "breakfast room."
